A Quarries Manager is appointed as the competent person to take charge of operations across all sites in accordance with Regulation 8(1)(c) of the Quarries Regulations 1999. A deputy has been appointed (8(1)(d)) and relevant Team Leaders and Supervisors (8(1)(d/e)) have also been appointed under the Quarries Regulations 1999.

Standards and Arrangements

Employing a management system that meets the requirements of ISO 45001:2018 by:

Providing the resources for the management and control of health and safety.

Eliminating hazards and reducing risk by employing safe systems of work and providing the necessary information, instruction, training and supervision. The consultation and participation of workers and their representatives and communicating health & safety matters using the appropriate methods

Providing health & safety rules, the required PPE, Welfare facilities, Emergency procedures, Fire and First Aid cover.

Performance

Monitoring, via the company's reporting system, all accidents, incidents, near misses, and opportunities for improvement. If our processes are found to be inadequate, we will identify, mitigate, correct and strive to continually improve.
